

Submitting an Enquiry

Submitting an enquiry can be done at the following address:

<http://xml.officebroker.com/Forms/Client/AffForm1.aspx>

Enquiries can be submitted using either URL variables or via POST. It is preferred that URL variables are used as this allows us to track submissions via server logs in the rare event that a problem may occur.

The following parameters are required:

AffID	Your alphanumeric affiliate ID – used to track who has send I the enquiry	
SiteID	Numerical ID specifying which of your sites submitted the enquiry	
CompanyName	Client's company name	Max 100
FirstName	Client's first name	Max 50
LastName	Client's first name	Max 50
Workstations	The amount of people the office will be expected to hold -1 Virtual office 0 Unknown / Not selected 1 – 100 Set number of workstations 101 100+ workstations	Integer -1 to 101
Telephone	Numbers,+ and - only	Max 50
Email	Client's email address, correctly formatted	

There are also several optional parameters which should be supplied when possible:

Size	The size of the office in square feet	Integer Max 32
SelectedOffices	A colon (:) separated list of offices selected by the client. E.g.: ID1:ID2:ID3	
SearchLocation	The location requested by the client E.g.: W1 or Mayfair, Greater London	
Mobile	The client's mobile phone number	Max 50
ExtraInfo	This is used as a free text field for the client to add extra requirements. This can also be prepended with any extra information which you may feel is relevant for the enquiry in question.	Long text field, no max

Some example code (with some php to speed things up) for the workstations would be as follows:
